HIGHLIGHTED ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Since its founding, the Buckeye Lake Region Community Foundation has achieved many significant milestones. Below is a highlight of major BLRCF accomplishments achieved over the past four years:

BUCKEYE LAKE REGION COMMUNITY FOUNDATION - MAJOR ACCOMPLISHMENTS 2016 - 2020

- Established the Buckeye Lake Region Corporation, providing continuous monetary and organizational support
- Serve as the primary funding resource to execute the vision of the BLR 2036 Declaration
- Funded the Gruen + Gruen Economic Impact Study
- Funded the EMH&T Buckeye Lake Watershed and Feeder Channel Water Quality Study
- Established charitable giving funds at the Licking, Fairfield and Perry County Foundations
- Coordinated and funded the Buckeye Lake Region Hospitality Plan executed by MKSK
- Coordinated and funded the Public Access Crystal Lagoon Economic Study executed by VenuBlue

- Coordinated and funded the Thorn Township Advisory Task Force
- Coordinated \$1,200,000 in grants for Feeder Channel restoration
- Secured \$200,000 for dredge recommissioning.
- Successfully advocated for the purchase of a new dredge for Buckeve Lake
- Secured \$392,000 for the Phase 1: Design and Concept to support the Buckeye Lake Region Corporation's efforts to re-imagine the North Shore Park
- Secured \$75,000 to support the Buckeye Lake Region Corporation's efforts to bring a public access crystal lagoon to Buckeye Lake
- Secured \$250,000 to begin structural and amenity upgrades to Canal Drive in Millersport





2020 GOALS AND PROJECTS

The Buckeye Lake Region Community Foundation seeks to achieve its mission by funding approaches that contribute to the transformation of the Buckeye Lake Region. Below is an overview of projects the Foundation was focused on in 2020, along with funding goals and project status.

NORTH SHORE COMMUNITY PARK TRANSFORMATION

The Foundation was instrumental in securing funds within the State of Ohio Capital Budget for the transformation of the North Shore Community Park located in the Village of Buckeye Lake. This transformation will include construction of a community pier, which is currently in the design and general engineering phase.

2020 FUNDING GOAL: SECURE FUNDING FOR PHASE 1: DESIGN AND CONCEPT
PROJECT STATUS: \$392K SECURED, PHASE 1 TO BE COMPLETED IN SPRING 2021

STATE OF OHIO CAPITAL BUDGET REQUESTS

The Foundation was instrumental in securing successful budget requests for multiple projects, across the Buckeye Lake Region, within the 2021 State of Ohio Capital Budget. These include: Millersport Canal Improvements: \$250K, Crystal Lagoon Economic Study: \$75K, Dredge recommissioning and purchase: \$200K. These budget requests will enable the ongoing work of both the Foundation and the Buckeye Lake Region Corporation.

2020 FUNDING GOAL: SECURE SUCCESSFUL BUDGET REQUESTS
PROJECT STATUS: FUNDING FOR ALL ITEMS SECURED

PUBLIC ACCESS CRYSTAL LAGOON

The Foundation secured funds to coordinate an economic and feasibility study by VenuBlue to evaluate the possibility of bringing a public access crystal lagoon to Buckeye Lake.

2020 FUNDING GOAL: SECURE FUNDING TO COMPLETE ECONOMIC AND FEASIBILITY STUDY.

PROJECT STATUS: \$50K IN FUNDING SECURED. STUDY AND CORRESPONDING INFOGRAPHIC COMPLETED

BUCKEYE LAKE REGION HOSPITALITY PLAN

The Foundation secured funds to coordinate a hospitality study and plan by MKSK to evaluate the potential hospitality and entertainment development opportunities across the Buckeye Lake Region.

2020 FUNDING GOAL: SECURE FUNDING TO COMPLETE ECONOMIC AND FEASIBILITY STUDY

PROJECT STATUS: \$50K IN FUNDING SECURED. STUDY AND CORRESPONDING INFOGRAPHIC COMPLETED

THORN TOWNSHIP ADVISORY TASK FORCE - TASKFORCE

At the request of Thorn Township, the Buckeye Lake Region Corporation assembled a task force of renowned designers, architects, engineers and environmental experts to provide Thorn Township with information on how to successfully develop the western side of Honey Creek. The Foundation provided monetary support to coordinate the task force and execute multiple Town Hall meetings.

2020 FUNDING GOAL: PROVIDE FUNDING TO SUPPORT THIS STRATEGIC BLRC INITIATIVE.

PROJECT STATUS: \$10K IN MONETARY SUPPORT PROVIDED TO THE BLRC. ADVISORY SERVICES PROVIDED

BY THE BLRC TO THORN TOWNSHIP. ONGOING SUPPORT TO BE PROVIDED THROUGH 2021

BUCKEYE LAKE REGION CORPORATION

Additional funding to maintain operation of the Buckeye Lake Region Corporation, which is the backbone of the Buckeye Lake Region Community Foundation's efforts.

PROJECT STATUS: ONGOING: 2020 FUNDING SECURED AND PROVIDED







2020 FINANCIALS AT-A-GLANCE

These financial contributions were utilized to continue forward momentum on critical, regional projects as well as to maintain the operations of the Foundation and the Buckeye Lake Region Corporation.




